**City Gospel Mission Homeless Shelter**

The City Gospel Mission Homeless Shelter is a 36- bed capacity transitional residence that provides homeless men with a safe, supportive place to stay as they participate in life skills training and stabilization services that prepare them for employment and permanent housing in the community.

**Ministry:** City Gospel Mission

**Position:** Case Manager (5 positions)

**Objective:** To assist homeless residents by providing case management services.

**Commitment:** A minimum of 3 hours per week for 12 weeks.

**Duties/Responsibilities:**

- Maintain a caseload of 3-5 clients.
- Develop mutually agreed upon case action plans.
- Document progress of residents.
- Research specific resources in the community that would be useful to residents.
- Conduct weekly case management sessions.

**Qualifications:**

Must be a Christ-follower with:

- Excellent communication and organizational skills.
- A heart for helping people with multiple barriers and from diverse cultural and socioeconomic backgrounds.
