Overview:

The Outlet creates a safe community space for the homeless to have fun and build positive relationships that will support recovery and healthy life choices. The Special Event Team determines, plans and facilitates various tournaments and activities offered at the Outlet (cards, corn hole, pool, Summerfest, Christmas Party, etc).

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Determine 2-3 large community events, set calendar and plan
- Lead and facilitate events
- Communicate with Special Event team leaders on calendar and supply needs
- Work with existing Outlet teams to execute plans
- Communicate events via bulletin board, flyers, etc.
- Facilitate set-up/clean-up of events

Qualifications

1. A heart and compassion for the homeless and those dealing with addictions and other obstacles.
2. Enjoys organizing and planning events and tournaments
3. Team-oriented

Time Commitment:

Approximately 4 hours per month. The Outlet takes place on Saturdays, 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 noon; and on the 1st Sunday of the month from 1:00-4:00
