



The Outlet

Overview:

The Outlet creates a safe community space for the homeless to have fun and build positive relationships that will support recovery and healthy life choices. Volunteers engage with our guests in a game room and coffee shop atmosphere. Play board games, shoot pool, serve coffee, or just hang out and engage in conversation. Help “behind” the scenes. Or, join a core “specialty” volunteer team: art, coffee shop/hospitality, music, and special events (see job descriptions). The Outlet takes place at City Gospel Mission, downstairs in the game room and dining hall.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Help with set-up of games and coffee
- Play board-games, shoot pool, play cards with guests
- Be a friendly listener and encourager
- Engage in conversations
- Assist with clean-up
