The Outlet Music Coordinator

Overview:

The Music team Coordinator schedules and facilitates live music and “open mic” events at the Outlet.

Responsibilities:

1. Read the City Gospel Mission Volunteer Handbook
2. Attend “Understanding Poverty” volunteer training
3. Set schedule/roster
4. Recruit musicians, singers, and performers to volunteer at the Outlet
(Note: integrate guests as well)
5. Communicate with Director concerning outlet calendar and supplies/logistical needs.
6. Orient new music volunteers to the Outlet (prior to or on-site) including equipment, set-up etc.
7. Attend monthly leadership team meetings
8. Inspire & engage guests through music—build long term relationships

3. Concerned about poverty & homelessness
4. Follower of Christ

6-8 hours a month
