

## **City Gospel Mission Volunteer Role Description**

**Ministry:** The Diner and Chapel

**Position:** Outreach Volunteer (individuals or small groups of 2-4)

**Objective:** Outreach Volunteers spend time at the Mission “hanging out”, talking with and getting to know our guests during chapel and dinner, developing relationships and friendships, while making a personal and spiritual impact in the lives of individuals.

**Commitment:** One evening per week, 6:30 – 8:30

**Duties/Responsibilities:**

- Attend a chapel service and dinner (or breakfast) on at least a weekly basis
- Get to know individuals and begin the process of building positive, interpersonal relationship by spending time with them during chapel, and during and after dinner.
- Refer individuals to services and the CGM Caseworkers as needed.
- Encourage people to take the next step in their live toward healing and wholeness
- Pray with and for your CGM friends as needed

**Qualifications:**

- Christ follower
- Excellent communication and relational skills
- Good active listening skills
- Able to set strong personal boundaries
- Ability and desire to work with adults from varied economic levels and backgrounds, including adults struggling with addictions and homelessness

- Attend An Introduction to Understanding Poverty through City Gospel Mission
- On the job training with Kevin Rosebrook and other staff
