

Procedures for Volunteering with City Gospel Mission

Individual volunteers

- Submit written or electronic volunteer application – complete all areas, including references; sign statement of faith.
- A preliminary interview with the Volunteer Coordinator will be scheduled. The volunteer placement may require an additional interview with the prospective supervisor.
- Volunteers will be placed in roles that are a good fit based on his or her interests, experience, gifts, and time availability.
- Certain positions may require a criminal background check.

Short-term volunteers

- Volunteers who want to volunteer for a one-time or limited period of time in order to obtain service hours for school or work should call or email at least two weeks in advance. Please be aware that the number of these short-term opportunities at any given time is limited.

Volunteer groups (schools, church groups, and corporate groups)

- Please schedule a month in advance – call or email
- When scheduling, the group leader should have a couple of dates in mind, the number of volunteers who will participate, and the type of project the group would like to do.
- Groups are scheduled on a first-come basis. The summer, fall, and the holidays tend to be extremely busy times for requests from groups.

Age Requirements

Individual volunteers – The minimum age for serving at the Mission is 10 years. Any youth under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult. We ask that anyone who volunteers is capable of making a contribution and that the focus remains on our guests and participants.

Group Volunteers – The minimum age for volunteer groups is junior high age. Youth under the age of 18 must be accompanied by one adult for every 10 volunteers.
